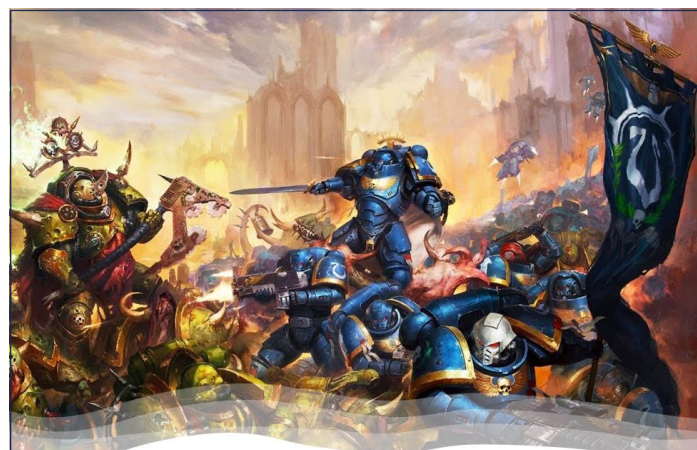


Hicks was very happy to see so many students come along to join in with the activities. You can see them below concentrating very hard on making keyrings.
