Parent Workshop

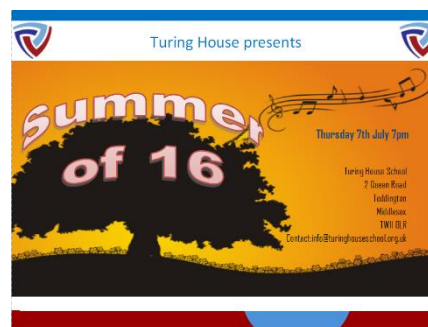
A reminder about our parent workshop on **Tuesday 28th June**.
