GDPR

The EU's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), which comes into force on 25th May, will give people much more control over how companies use their information. It also includes specific rules to protect youngsters whose personal data is processed in order to provide them with online services.

WhatsApp has now changed its age requirement from 13 to 16. The app, which is owned by Facebook, will ask users to confirm their age when prompted to agree new terms of service in the next few weeks.

As you can imagine, social media issues have an impact on children's mental health as well as contributing to a significant amount of teacher time dealing with out of school disagreements online. Parents/carers are requested to ensure that the requirements are followed to help us focus on learning.
