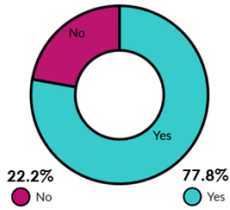

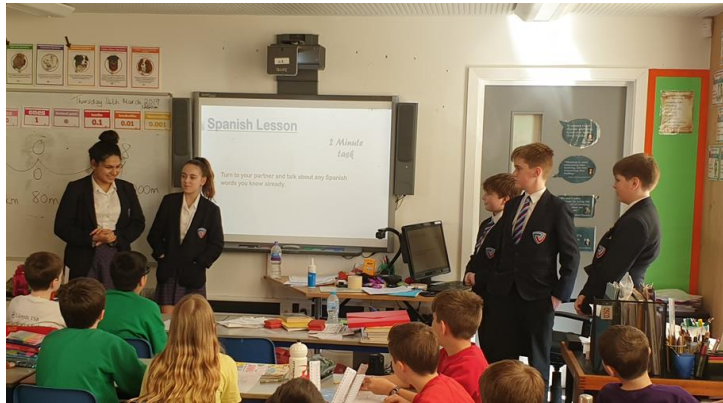
## Good Diabetes Care in School Award

**Literacy Focus**



Colons are used for three main reasons:

To join two clauses together, where the second clause explains the first. E.g. I can't wait for Monday: I've got a 6 period day.

To introduce items in a list. E.g. I have three wishes: more time, more money, more sleep.

To introduce a quotation. E.g. The writer used her favourite quote: 'all's well that ends well'.



**Parent Mail Outlook/Hotmail Spam Issue**

We have been advised by ParentMail of an issue with Outlook and Hotmail inboxes incorrectly classifying ParentMail emails as spam, meaning parents may be unaware of emails they are receiving from ParentMail.
