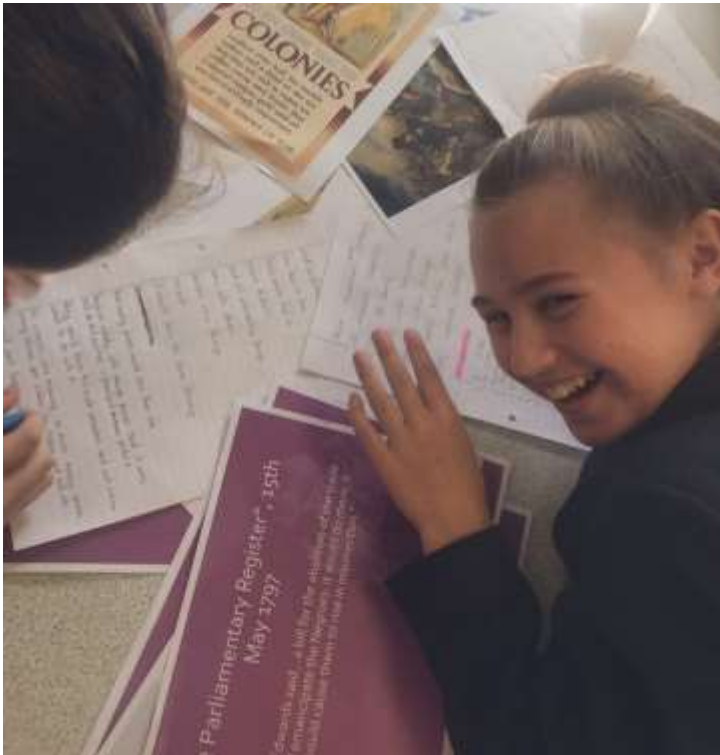

## ALL ABOUT SLEEP

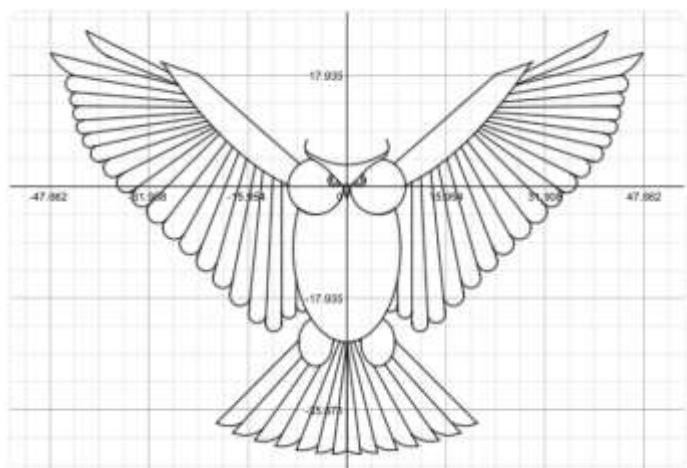
Young people need 8-10 hours sleep each night. If you are not getting enough sleep, you will feel tired, grumpy and less able to concentrate. You will also feel sleepy during the daytime and find yourself becoming **slow and irritable** in the late afternoon and early evening. It's likely you won't be getting enough sleep!
